

**Probating Will being filed simultaneously therewith on that same date;**

**The relevant real estate is more particularly described as follows; to-wit:**

**A certain tract of land lying and being in Clay County, Kentucky, on branch known as Court House Branch waters of Crane Creek of the South Fork of the Kentucky river. Beginning on left side of road as you go up said branch at corner stone near Lee Byrd's barn where it now stands; Thence a straight line to main branch; Thence east to a pine on center of point; Thence with the divide of ridge to a corner line between Taylor Spurlock's and Lee Byrd's; Thence a south course with the divide between furnace branch and Court House Branch to a black gum corner tree at Henry Hacker's line; thence with line of same to a corner stone at main branch with 2 ½ acres reserved. Beginning at the corner stone; thence down the branch to a beech tree at a spring; Thence straight up the hill to the Country road; Thence with the road to a corner stone at the mouth of a drain near the Steve Mobley and Henry Hacker's line to the top of the hill at the Poll Baily to a corner owned by John H. Callahan; Thence with the divide of said point in a eastward course back to the country road to a walnut tree; Thence with said road to the beginning.**
